an activist priest provides sanctuary for an encampment of unhoused people in her churchyard the housing crisis plaguing major urban centres has sent countless people into the streets in spring 2022 some of them found their way to the yard beside the anglican church in toronto s kensington market where maggie helwig is the priest they pitched tents formed an encampment and settled in known as an outspoken social justice activist helwig has spent the last three years getting to know the residents and fighting tooth and nail to allow them to stay battling various authorities that want to clear the yard and

keep the results of the housing crisis out of sight and out of mind encampment tells the story of helwig s life long activism as preparation for her fight to keep her churchyard open to people needing a home more importantly it introduces us to the artist to jeff and to robin their lives their challenges their humanity it confronts our society s callousness in allowing so many to go unhoused and demands by bringing their stories to the fore that we begin to respond with compassion and grace

from los angeles to boston and chicago to miami us cities are struggling to address the twin crises of high housing costs and household instability debates over the appropriate course of action have been defined by two poles building more housing or enacting stronger tenant protections these options are often treated as mutually exclusive with support for one implying opposition to the other shane phillips believes that effectively tackling the housing crisis requires that cities support both tenant protections and housing abundance he offers readers more than 50 policy recommendations beginning with a set of principles and general recommendations that should apply to all housing policy the remaining recommendations are organized by what he calls the three s s of supply stability and subsidy phillips makes a moral and economic case for why each is essential and recommendations for making them work together there is no single solution to the housing crisis it will require a comprehensive approach backed by strong diverse coalitions the affordable city is an essential tool for professionals and advocates working to improve affordability and increase community resilience through local action
